IMPORTANT PASSPORT INFORMATION

The Thailand National Park requires each guest's passport information 14 days prior to departure to process a required diving permit. No name changes can be made less than 7 days prior to departure. Your passport information will be taken from the GIS (GUEST INFORMATION SYSTEM) and sent to the yacht. Full name in GIS <u>must</u> match passport with date of birth, passport nationality and passport number. Failure to complete the GIS prior to the charter departure will result in being denied permission to board and dive on the charter start date.

The National Park requires all divers to be certified scuba divers. Therefore, the yacht is not permitted to teach open water courses onboard. Non-divers can snorkel in the National parks.

ARRIVAL

The Thailand Aggressor offers 2 itineraries with each departing from a different port. Transfers are complimentary on the embark/disembark dates at the following pick-up points. **If guests have booked a travel package with Aggressor Detours, private transfers can be arranged upon request. For guests who book their own hotel or land packages, we are unable to book private transfers.**

REQUIREMENT

TRANSFERS

Please Note: 7 Day advance notification is required for transfer arrangements

<u>For Transfers from Phuket International Airport (HKT):</u> For international flights, guests will be met and picked up at the international arrival area, exit 5, between 4:00-5:00 pm on the charter start day. For guests who have arrived early and want to be transferred to the yacht on the charter start day, please meet at the Chair Café at 127 1 Sakhu, Thalang District, Phuket 83110, Thailand between 4:00-5:00 pm.

North Andaman Sea Itinerary: Guests will be greeted and picked up at 4:00 pm from the Phuket International Airport (HKT) and pick-up from the host hotels, the Kantary Beach Hotel and Villas or the Khao Lak Palm Beach Resort, will be between 4 – 5:00 pm for transfer to Thap Lamu. All guests will be on board by 6 pm (approx.) and the yacht will depart from the dock Saturday evening. After all the guests have arrived, we provide them with the briefing and dinner.

The Thailand Aggressor will return to the dock on Friday late afternoon. Check-out is 8:00 am Saturday morning. The staff will transport guests to the airport (HKT) or host hotel following the cruise. **hotel drop-off within 5km of airport**

<u>South Andaman Sea Itinerary</u>: Guests will be greeted and picked up at 4:00 pm from the Phuket International Airport (HKT) for transfer to Visit Panwa Pier. Pick-up from the host hotel, Westin Siray Bay Resort and Spa will be between 6:00 – 7:00pm. All guests will be on board by 8 pm (approx.) and the yacht will depart from the dock around 9:00 pm Saturday evening. After all the guests have arrived, we provide them with the briefing and dinner.

The Thailand Aggerssor will return to the dock on Friday early evening. Check-out is 8:00 am Saturday morning. The staff will transport guests to the airport (HKT) or host hotel following the cruise. **hotel drop-off within 5km of airport**

WELCOME

In the event of an emergency, family and friends may contact you at the above numbers. If you need to reach the yacht, please call, or e-mail the boat. There is a satellite phone onboard for emergency communication. We recommend you pack a change of clothes, swimsuit, medication, and toiletries in your carry-on bag, in case of an unexpected luggage delay.

PASSPORTS & DOCUMENTATION

All travelers must have a passport valid for at least six (6) months beyond their period of stay, adequate funds to support themselves, and a return airline ticket when traveling. It is the traveler's responsibility to ensure they have the correct

documentation for entry into each country on their itinerary, including any visas required, as well as documentation for re-entry to their home country.

Visa and entry requirements vary by destination and are subject to change. Travelers should check with the appropriate consulate or embassy of each country they plan to visit. U.S. citizens may refer to the U.S. Department of State website at www.travel.state.gov for passport and visa information, including requirements for children and consulate contacts by country. International travelers should consult the equivalent agency or foreign affairs office in their own country for destination-specific travel requirements and re-entry regulations.

A useful resource for checking current travel, visa, and health requirements is the IATA Travel Centre.

Please note: There are specific requirements for children departing the United States, and many countries have adopted similar measures for child protection. The Reservation Office and staff cannot assume responsibility for passengers who do not have the correct documentation.

C-CARDS

Remember to bring your c-card or proof of certification. The divemaster requires proof of certification before the first dive. If you are a repeat guest, you are automatically enrolled in the *Travel the World Club* and will receive onboard discounts. Your membership is indicated on the captain's rooming list.

GIS (GUEST INFORMATION SYSTEM)

The Reservations Office and the Thailand Aggressor require each guest to complete a Cruise Application and Waiver prior to departure and diving through the online GIS (Guest Information System). The GIS (Guest Information System) allows guests to interactively complete all required paperwork that includes the application/waiver, special requests, and travel information. The earlier you complete your GIS the better for the staff to adequately prepare for the charter. In addition to your arrival and departure flight information, please include any lodging information if applicable. If you have not received a link to complete the online Guest Information System (GIS), please call an Aggressor Liveaboards agent. *Passengers who fail to complete it will be denied boarding.* Many Aggressor destinations require passenger information for itinerary approval.

INSURANCE

We strongly recommend each guest purchase comprehensive accident, medical, baggage and trip cancellation and interruption insurance when space is reserved. Trip insurance will protect you from financial disappointment if you are prevented from making your scheduled trip due to illness, family illness or if unforeseen circumstances prevent the airline or yacht from making it. In the event you cancel your trip, be familiar with Aggressor Liveaboards cancellation policies, which can be found on www.aggressor.com. More information can be found on Dive assure or Divers Alert Network insurance on our website.

FEES & TAXES (per person)

Each guest must pay a \$95 park fee onboard at the end of the charter by Visa, MasterCard, or in cash (USD/THB), when diving any North or South 7-night itinerary. A 7% VAT tax for onboard services/purchases must also be paid onboard. Fees and taxes are not included in the charter rate.

HEALTH

The Thailand Aggressor has a first aid kit onboard, including oxygen and an AED. You may want to bring motion sickness medication if you feel you will need it. We suggest you bring over-the-counter motion sickness medication or consult your doctor about prescription brands, such as the trans-dermal patch or Scopace tablets. Currents and winds may cause moderate movement of the yacht at times. We recommend a complete physical before your trip. There is a recompression chamber in Phuket, Bangkok and Samui.

Aggressor yachts and their staff are unable to accept any medication brought onboard for safe keeping including those that require refrigeration. Should a guest have a medication requiring temperature control, they will need to travel with a travel cooling case or small storage cooler with several blue ice packets. The staff will be happy to store and recharge the blue ice but are unable to accept possession of or responsibility for the proper care and storage of medication. This should be kept in your

stateroom. There is NO smoking allowed inside the yacht or on the dive deck. Smoking is only permitted on the bow of the aggressor.

THE THAILAND AGGRESSOR

The Thailand Aggressor was built in 1977 and refurbished in 2024. She is 35m x 7m, with 2 x diesel cummins engine, a top speed of 12 knots and cruising speed of 9 knots. The yacht has 220V-240V power onboard. All staterooms are air-conditioned and fitted with private bathrooms and a porthole or picture window. Breakfast (cooked to order), buffet lunch and an elegant chef prepared dinner with tableside service are served in addition to mid-afternoon snacks. Beverages (soft beverages, local beer, and wine with dinner) are complimentary while onboard. The yacht is equipped with hairdryers and bathrobes in each stateroom. Linens are changed mid-week and fresh towels are placed in each stateroom as needed. Filled tanks, weights, and weight belts are included.

FOOD

The menu onboard is varied and plentiful, with a variety of Thai feasts and local cuisine. You will awaken to fresh fruits, hot entrees, cereals, and juices. Lunches are buffet-style, featuring delicious local cuisine. Dinners are served each evening and include salads, vegetables, seafood, beef, or chicken with a fresh homemade dessert. If you have any special dietary requirements, please be sure these are noted under *special dietary requests* when completing the GIS. Once onboard, please speak to the chef about any special dietary needs. Certain special dietary and beverage requests may not be available due to the remote nature of this location.

Aggressor yachts, river cruises, signature lodges and floating resorts operate in remote locations which limits the availability of certain foods and edibles, which can be unavailable in grocery stores and markets. While our culinary teams strive to accommodate individual requests, it is important to recognize that they cannot guarantee it despite their best efforts. Guests with dietary restrictions and food allergies should be aware that the same meal is prepared for all guests, making cross contamination a possibility. Based on this, travelers should plan accordingly and bring prepackaged goods if needed. The availability of fresh produce may vary weekly, and they may have a limited selection depending on the destination and availability. The concept of "organic" is infrequent, and items like "gluten-free" products are seldom found in these remote locations.

BEVERAGES

The Aggressor's selection includes fruit juices, soft drinks, iced water, iced tea, coffee, and a limited selection of local beer and wine (wine is served with dinner), which are complimentary. Due to the high duty charged on liquor, we suggest you bring your special brand from the U.S. Due to local regulations; the bar will be closed while the boat is in port. Drinking and diving do not mix. Once you consume alcohol, you become a sunbather until the next day.

CLOTHING

We recommend that you pack your gear in soft luggage such as a duffel bag for easy stowage and to add to your comfort in your cabin. Clothing should be lightweight, comfortable sportswear; sunscreen and swimsuits are necessary. A light sweater or jacket is ideal for evenings. The dress is always casual and informal. Additional items you may want to bring are sunglasses and walking shoes for your time on shore.

INTERNET/EMAIL

There is an onboard satellite communications device for emergencies. The yacht is in cellular range occasionally, where cellular-based WiFi Internet (3G and above) connectivity (email) becomes available. This will depend on your service provider and the yacht's location. If you need to contact the outside world, please ask the staff in what areas a signal might be available. All communication services the destination provides are charged based on data usage (airtime). Email service (if available) is restricted to text-only messages.

VOLTAGE ABOARD THE YACHT

The voltage aboard the yacht is 220v A/C sockets. See below for an example of the outlets available onboard.



ENTERTAINMENT

There is a variety of nightly entertainment, including diving, fish identification presentations, movies, games and more. If you have a favorite movie, digital presentation, or a video to share, we encourage you to bring it along. The staff especially loves new releases of movies, recent magazines, and books. A small library of books for exchange and fish identification books for reference is maintained onboard.

CELEBRATING A SPECIAL OCCASION

If you will be celebrating a special occasion like an anniversary, birthday, honeymoon, wedding, or your 100th dive, please let us know so the staff can celebrate your occasion. Kindly advise the Reservations Office prior to traveling so the staff is notified in advance.

DIVING CONDITIONS

Each of the itineraries offers remote, pristine diving with something a little different. The water temperature varies from 28 - 30C/83 -84F and air temperature 25 - 27C/78 - 89F. These unique itineraries offer diving on healthy and vibrant reefs, seamounts, sheer walls, caves, beautiful coral gardens and magnificent critter dives. A 3mm wetsuit and hood is recommended. All diving is from tenders.

DIVING

The staff of the Thailand Aggressor, with their unique combination of talents, offers the ultimate service. While onboard, you may pick a dive buddy of your choice. The yacht offers up to five dives per day (including night dives) and depends on the weather and itinerary.

The Thailand Aggressor provides 80 cubic ft. tanks with DIN/yoke adaptable valves, weight belts and weights. (100 cu ft tanks are available by request) All dives will be made from two dive tenders. Enjoy freshwater showers on the back deck after your dives and dry off with a warm towel. All diving onboard the Thailand Aggressor should be within the limits and standards of the training agency that certified you. All dives should be planned as no decompression dives.

DIVING SUPERVISION

We understand that diving is not just an activity; it's a passion for exploring our underwater world. That's why we empower you and your buddy to take charge of your diving experience. While in the water, you and your buddy are in charge. Every dive begins with a comprehensive briefing from our experienced staff, providing you with the necessary information. As certified divers, you and your buddy are responsible for planning and conducting your dives while respecting the limits of your experience and those set by the briefing and your certification agency.

On the Thailand Aggressor, all dives are conducted from tenders. A staff member will accompany each tender group and be in the water to offer assistance and ensure the group stays together. However, we do not directly supervise divers; each buddy team still manages their dive. If a buddy team needs to surface early, the entire group is not required to abort the dive and follow. The buddy team should follow the briefing and their training procedures for surfacing from a dive and signal the tender driver that everything is OK once on the surface. Once the dive time expires (per the briefing), the staff member will organize the remaining buddy teams to surface together for pickup by the tender.

DIVE GEAR SUGGESTIONS

We suggest you pack the following: mask, fins, snorkel, regulator with pressure gauge, depth gauge, buoyancy compensator, dive computer, dive light, mirror, safety sausage, Dive Alert and/or other safety devices. Although not required, a reef hook is

suggested for occasional dives. Dive computers are mandatory for each guest. Each piece of gear should be marked with waterproof paint or tape.

CONSERVATION LAWS

Conservation laws do not permit fishing or collecting. Reef hooks are not permitted. Drones are allowed. There is no drone permit required, but they cannot be flown in the national park areas. Please verify at the time of travel.

RENTAL DIVE EQUIPMENT

A full line of Mares rental gear is available aboard including regulators, BCDs, Dive Computers, and Night Lights. If any of your dive equipment fails while onboard, the staff will loan you equipment free of charge, compliments of Mares.

We strongly recommend bringing your own wetsuit to ensure optimal comfort and thermal protection during your dives. This destination does offer rental wetsuits. The storage space on the liveaboard is limited, meaning we can only stock a few sizes for men and a few for women. Since a wetsuit fit is highly individual and crucial for both comfort and warmth, bringing your personal wetsuit will provide the best diving experience. Other rental equipment is readily available, but the unique nature of wetsuit sizing makes this piece particularly important to bring along.

USE OF SCOOTERS ELECTRIC SURFBOARDS & SIMILAR DEVICES

For the safety of our guests, staff, and the marine environment, underwater scooters, electric surfboards (e-foils, jet-boards, powered surfboards, and similar devices) are not permitted on any Aggressor Adventures yacht or destination.

CERTIFICATION & SPECIALTY COURSES

Divers can further their education while onboard an Aggressor yacht. The following courses are offered onboard: SSI Adventurer Course or the PADI equivalent Advanced Open Water Diver Course, and SSI or PADI Enriched Air / Nitrox Courses. Course fees are payable once onboard and the instructor confirms the course. The training agency utilized to provide 5 your course will vary based on your instructor's affiliations. Other specialty courses may be available onboard and will be presented to you after your arrival as part of your initial briefings.

PHOTO/VIDEO EQUIPMENT

The Thailand Aggressor offers free coaching. The aggressor has a 110-volt strobe charging station and a large camera table available for your camera and video equipment. Guests should bring their own battery chargers.

UNDERWATER VIDEO

Our Video Professional can capture your diving adventure onboard the Thailand Aggressor to share with family and friends. The video for the week (including all guests and staff) is USD \$65 per person.

SHIPS BOUTIQUE & CREDIT CARDS

There is a mini boutique onboard, which sells a small selection of logo clothing including t-shirts, caps, and other items. One day during the week, the staff will have a 'boutique day.' The Thailand Aggressor accepts cash, Visa & MasterCard. Sorry, no personal checks, Travelers Checks, Amex, or Discover Cards. Credit card payments made on board the yacht incur a 2.5% service charge. Many credit card companies are charging conversion fees. If this happens to you, please contact your credit card company. If you would like to purchase additional boutique items after your trip, visit www.aggressor.com.

GRATUITIES

Staff gratuities are not included in the charter. We believe gratuities should be voluntary and based upon the quality of service the staff has provided. When settling your account, the captain will have an envelope for gratuities that will be divided equally among the staff. Payment can be made by cash or credit card. Sorry no personal checks or travelers' checks.

RETURN TO PORT

The day before departure at the end of the trip, the yacht will return Friday to the port early in the evening. **Guests will not arrive back to port in time to fly out this day.** A cocktail party and dinner will be held onboard the last evening of the charter.

CHECKOUT

Final disembarkation will occur on the morning of the last day of the charter. Guests will be transported to the airport for a domestic flight back, or to the host hotel if guests are extending their stay. **Optional hotel drop-off within 5km of airport**

For any guest choosing to extend their stay our staff will be happy to organize tours to give you time to enjoy the land sites. All tours are at an additional charge and are highly recommended.
